



Overview







The camp gas been built in typical East-African style and is of a very high standard. It is beautifully situated, very comfortable, and offers spacious insect-proof tents (double tents) equipped with good beds, bed-linen, bedside tables, clothes-racks, shelves and chairs. All tents also have private toilets and showers, with hot and cold running water. Furthermore these is a cozy mess "tent". A well-stocked bar with a refrigerator to provide ice cold drinks is naturally also part of the camp.

Meals are of a very high standard. Every morning you will be served a good solid breakfast including fresh fruit, bacon and eggs, freshly baked bread, and coffee or tea. Lunch is camp consists of 2 -3 courses, while on the days you are hunting in far flung parts of the district, you will bring along a delicious picnic lunch. Dinner always consists of a 2-3 course meal, with a selection of good wines, spirits and other drinks that match the high quality of the food.

A 4 wheel drive ATV is at the disposal of our hunters. Even though this vehicle is in the best possible condition, and that there are good mechanics employed in camp, the terrain here is very

hard on all vehicles, you must make allowances for the fact break-downs do occur occasionally, which can lead to the loss of some time that would have been spent hunting.

There is a radio transmitter in camp, so it is always possible to contact the head office in Dar-Es-Salaam. It is also possible to hire a satellite telephone for US\$50 per week.


On arrival at Dar-Es-Salaam or Arusha/Kilimanjaro you will be met by a representative from the safari company, who will help with arrivals formalities. He will also help with arrangements for you transfer to the hunting camp, either using domestic flights and a car, or a chartered light aircraft.

## HUNTING AREA Lukwati South Game Reserve

Lukwati lies in western Tanzania and this fantastic big game district is one of the absolute best that Tanzania can offer. It is one of the most productive and best taken care of hunting districts anywhere. For many years the former concession holders made great efforts in the fields of wildlife management and poaching control, while the district's remote location also helps to protect the game populations here.

From the north-eastern shores of Lake Rukwa, this hunting concession stretches east "the Escarpment" to large, pristine miombo forests. The district is renown for big buffalo, sable, it's many leopards, and a very high success rate for it's hunts for handsomely maned lions. Lukwati is a wonderful natural biotope with a high level of diversity: the large lake, Lake Rukwa, marshes and swamps, forests, rivers, open savannah, rocks, mountains, and water from natural springs.

In Lukwati it is possible to hunt the following game species: lion, buffalo, leopard, elephant, sable, kudu, roan, eland, hippopotamus, crocodile, Lichtenstein's Hartebeest, Defassa Waterbuck, zebra, southern reedbuck, warthog, oribi, bushpig,

common duiker, impala, hyena and jackals.

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
It is possible to charter a light aircraft to fly you directly to Lukwati from either Arusha or Dar Es Salaam. It is also possible to take a scheduled domestic flight to Mbeya, from where it is approximately a 4-6 hour drive to camp, depending on weather conditions.

The hunting season in Tanzania is from 1st July to 31st December. The best period to hunt at Lukwati is from August to November.
